



Dear 2018-2019 Lot 203 (University Crossing) Park and Ride Participant:

Parking

Permit parking in the lot is enforced 6:30am-4:30pm Monday-Friday. Permit holders may also park in the lot on weekdays outside of these hours if they are going to work. The lot will be closed on state holidays. Alternate parking on campus is available on weekdays when park and ride lot is closed.

Permits are only valid in the two signed lot 203 surface lot sections at 702 University Row (see diagram on next page). There is no parking in the lot adjacent to the Digestive Health building or at any other lot or location in the area not signed as Lot 203.

Lot 203 (University Crossing) Shuttle

A no fare shuttle will be available to permit holders. All shuttle times are approximate. The shuttle schedule is subject to delays due to construction, weather, and traffic. You must have a Lot 203 parking permit in order to use the shuttle service.

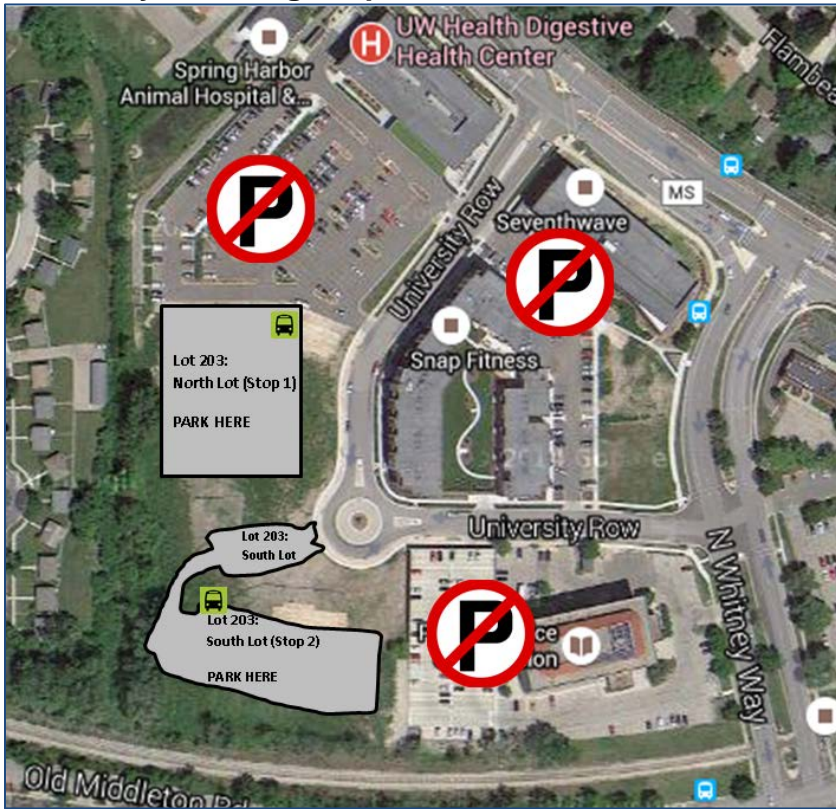
- Shuttle service Monday-Friday.
- Peak service: 6:00- 9:30am and 3:30-7:30pm
- Off-peak service: 9:30am-3:30pm. There is no 1:00pm shuttle due to driver break.
- The shuttle will pick up at the designated stop or shelter only. Please be waiting at the stop/shelter when the shuttle arrives. Do not wait in your car or away from the stop.
- The shuttle stops at 4 health science campus shuttle stop locations and loops directly back to lot 203 via Highland Avenue. The shuttle comes every 5 to 15 minutes at peak and every 30 minutes at off peak. There are two stops at University Crossing, one each in the north and south portions of the lot.
- No parking or shuttle service on state holidays. If you need to park for work-related reasons on any of these days, you can park in Lots 34, 41, 45, 46, 60 or 62. Remember to display your annual parking permit. UW observed state holidays include Thanksgiving, Christmas Eve, Christmas, New Year's Eve, New Year's Day, Martin Luther King Jr. Day, Monday, Memorial Day, Labor Day

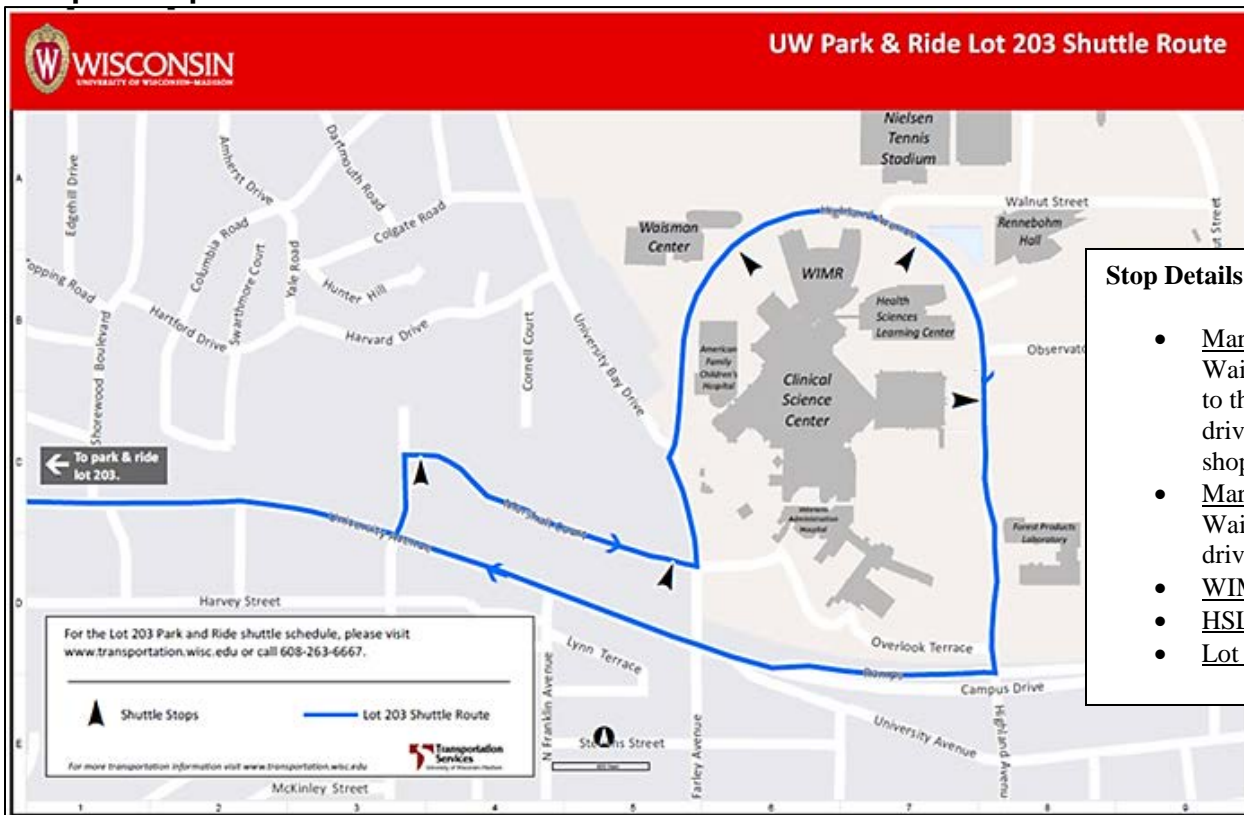

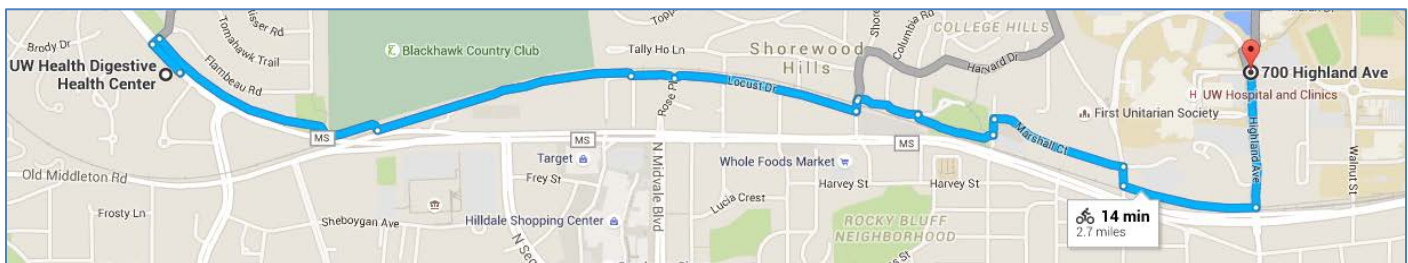
City Bus Service

Metro Routes 10 and 72 serve the park and ride. Via transfer to the Route 2, 28, and 38 Park and Ride users can access the health science campus.

Biking from the Park and Ride

There is a very good bicycle route from Lot 203 to the UW Campus. The route is about 3 miles and takes 15 minutes or less. Cross University Ave and take the bike path (turn right –eastward-onto the path). At the first fork in the path, take the right fork (then veer left shortly after this fork to continue eastward). The path will follow the railroad tracks for a time after this. Take the path until it ends on Locus Dr. Continue via bike lanes to Shorewood Blvd. Turn left then right onto the short path there. The path will exit to Purdue St. Take the drive/path around the pool (this will soon be by-passed by a path) to Marshall Ct. Turn left on Marshall Ct, then right at the stop sign. Continue to University Bay Dr. From here you can turn left to get to the hospital or turn right to access the Campus Drive Path at the corner of University Ave. Take the path to campus points east.





Emergency Ride Home

Daily Permits

You can purchase half-day (\$9) or daily (\$15) permit for those times when you need to have your car on campus. Weekend and Evening Parking On Campus

After 4:30pm on weekdays and all day on Saturday and Sunday, Park and Ride participants may use their permit to park in lots on campus that allow ANY valid UW annual permit (i.e. "Lots controlled at all times"). The Park and Ride Permit must be displayed when parked after hours in these lots. In addition, a limited number of lots on campus are free for the public (no permit is required) after 4:30 p.m. on weekdays and all day Saturday and Sunday (i.e. "Lots controlled 7:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m."). Bus Pass Pickup

Bus passes may be ordered online at <https://uwtransservices.t2hosted.com/Account/Portal>. You must have an activated NetID to order a pass. Passes for 2018-2019 will be available after August 1, 2018. UW Medical School and other UW employees will be charged \$48 for the employee bus pass and will order and pay for the pass (via credit card or payroll deduction) online and receive the bus pass in the mail. NOTE: State Historical Society, UW Foundation, Alumni Association, and WARF/WICELL employees must retrieve their passes directly from their respective organizations. Graduate assistants and student hourly positions are not eligible for an employee bus pass, but may pick up a student pass from ASM if they pay segregated fees. Members of the Retirement Association are not eligible for a complimentary pass.
